College/University/Institutes of Technology

- ▶ Applications open in early October - YukonU middle of October
- ▶ Early admission - **University** - based on grade 11 marks - projection - conditional offer
- ▶ First qualified/first accepted - **College and Institutes of Technology** - limited enrollment
- ▶ Direct Entry from high school - Social Work, Radiation Therapist
- ▶ 1st and 2nd choices
- ▶ **Admission decisions are based on:** Competitive Average for required courses/personal profile/supplementary applications/interviews/portfolio/audition/math contest/CASPER test/who applies first.
- ▶ Students whose first language is not English may need to complete English language proficiency testing.
